

The plough has wheels on the front, so that it could easily be taken from field to field. The major innovation lies in the way the plough cuts. On the frame ahead of the share is a knife, placed vertically to cut the sod and make it easier for the share to enter the thick soil. Behind the share is a curved, wing-like board, sitting diagonally to the frame, to lift the cut sod and throw it clear to the right, like a wave
